WHEN TO SEEK HELP

Children and adolescents with mental health concerns need to get help as soon as possible. Pay attention if a child or adolescent you know has any of these warning signs:

- Refusing to attend or declining performance in school
- Extreme fearfulness or excessive worrying
- Persistent sadness and crying or hopelessness
- Recurrent negative feelings about oneself
- Uncontrollable anger, outbursts or overreacting
- Repetitive stealing
- Using alcohol or other drugs
- Obsessive dieting and/or exercising
- Seeing things or hearing voices that cannot be explained
